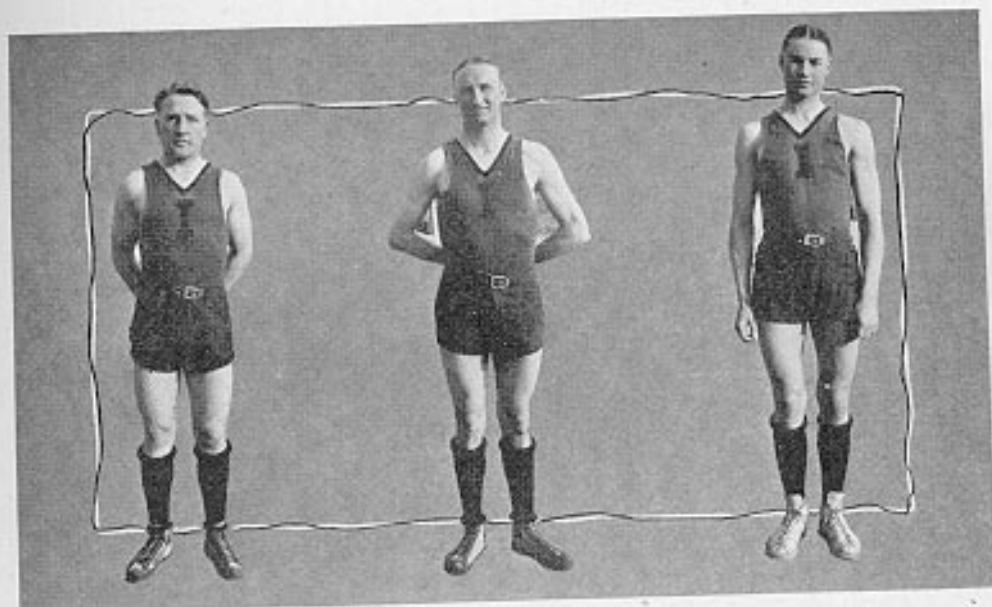

Capt. of 1924 Quintet

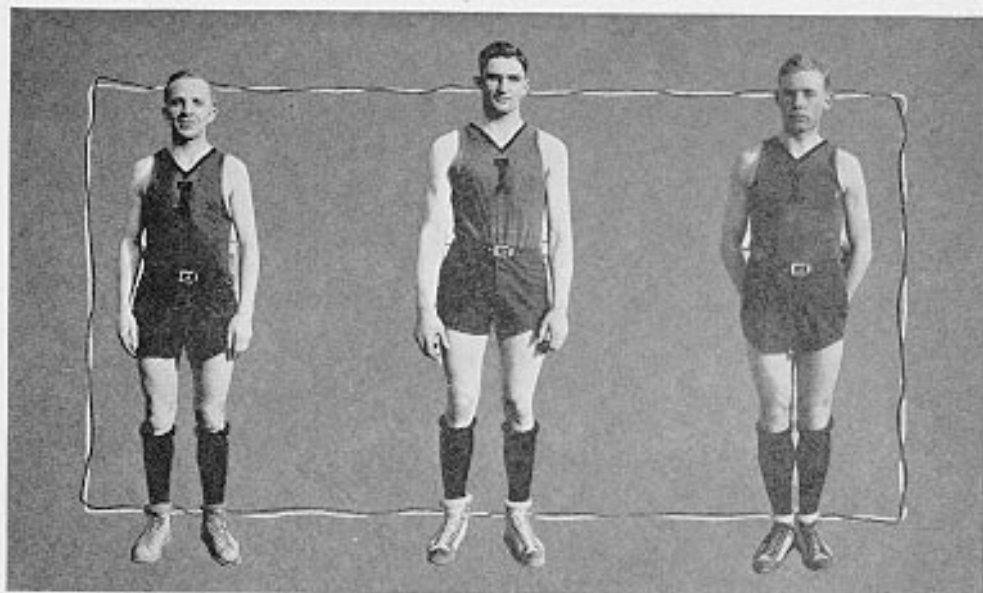

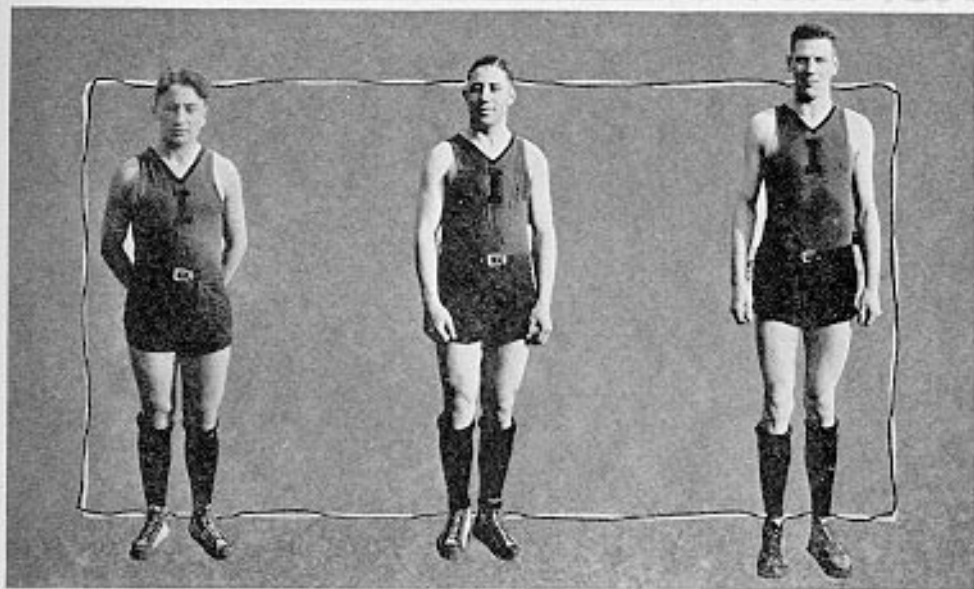
Wayne Garrett
